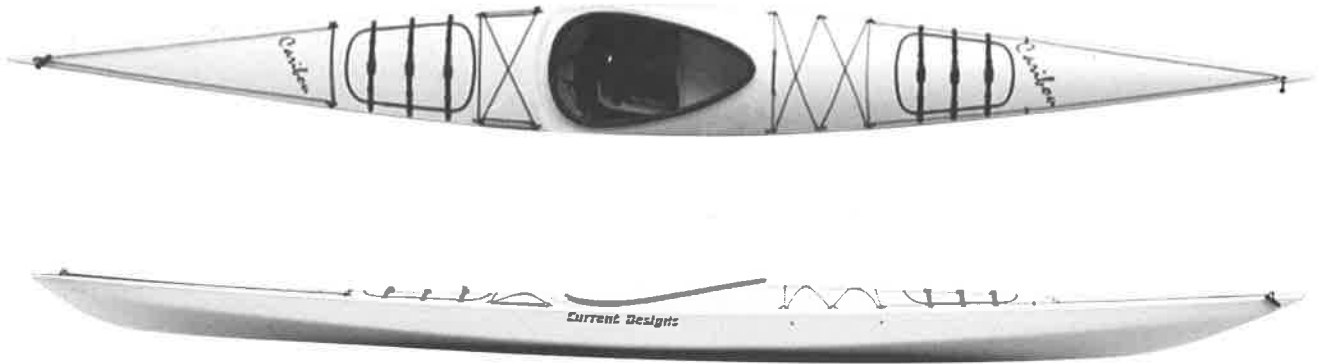


Current Designs

The Caribou



It's **fun, playful** and **pure magic**.

When Brian Henry saw and paddled the Caribou, he was so impressed that he asked its designer, Barry Buchanan if he would like Current Designs to produce his kayak. We are very proud to include Barry's wonderful kayak design in the Current Designs family.

The Caribou is best described as a modified Greenland design with a narrow, hard chine hull and a low deck profile. This hard chine hull design offers unusually high stability. The narrow beam and the low deck offer reduced windage and a sporty appeal.

The Caribou features a clean deck arrangement with flush fiberglass hatches fore and aft. The seat comes with a comfortably padded backband. The easy to enter cockpit is molded with padded thigh braces shaped to fit a wide range of paddler sizes.

A long, narrow craft with a clean appearance and a gracefully sweeping sheer line, the Caribou displays its performance bred heritage by its very presence. The Caribou is fast, nimble, and a pure joy to paddle.
