The Squall (Rotomolded)



The Squall is the smaller sister of the Storm. It is scaled down for the smaller paddler or for someone wanting a slimmer, tighter fitting craft with all of the features and details of the Storm.

At just over 22" wide and 16 1/2" long, this quick little polyethylene kayak is zippy and fun but extremely predictable in every move. The same shallow "V" hull gives a lively feel, yet a strong sense of security when leaned over on its side.

The 29" long cockpit allows good contact and allows superb control of the Squall.

This fine sistership of the Storm is appropriately named Squall (a small storm).
